

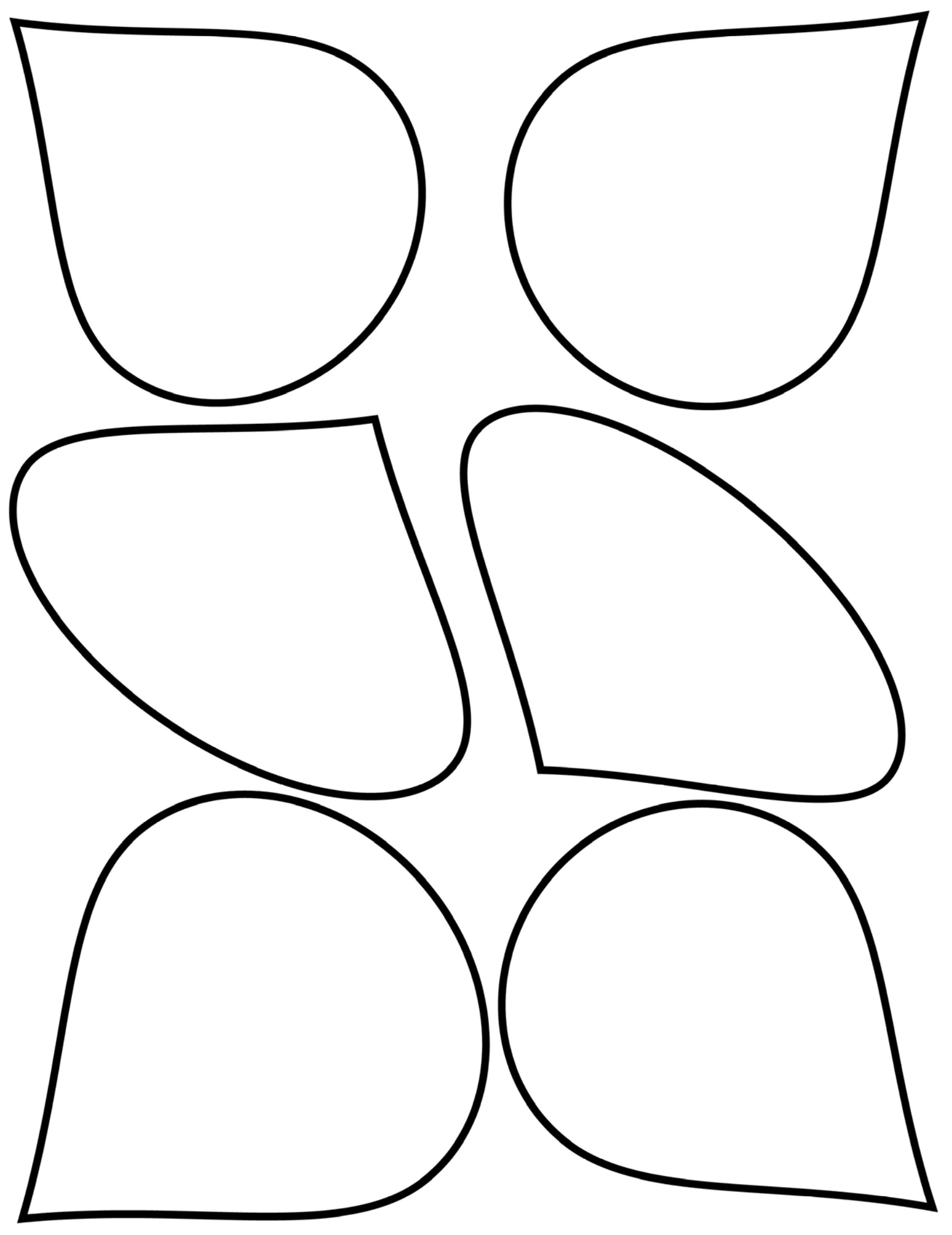
Making Super Simple Christmas Ornaments any Church (Child) can be proud of.

You might just make enough copies to send one home with each child.

The ornaments themselves are simple...get scissors and paper and cut out any shape you (or the child) wants. You can use construction paper, brown paper bags or gift wrap left over from the year before...you can even use plain white paper or cardboard. Each child cuts out three shapes (circles stars etc.) glue or tape one of our little Christmas Scriptures on one side of each ornament... and then decorate any way you like ...with markers, with glue and glitter... or with little bits of ribbon and yarn. On the other side of the first ornament write one of Jesus Names to remind you that Christmas is somebody's birthday. On the second write one of the gifts he brought to earth (peace, joy, love, forgiveness etc) to remind us that we are supposed to give the same kind of gifts. On the third glue another scripture to remind us that God's word is a light every day of the year and not just one.
